

SOUTHWEST FLORIDA COUNCIL - BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA THE COUNCIL SERVICE CENTER AND SCOUT SHOP

Formed in 1967, the Southwest Florida Council serves over 29,000 young people and 3,775 volunteers in Manatee, Sarasota, Charlotte, Lee, Collier, DeSoto and Hendry Counties. The council is governed by a volunteer executive board of area business and civic leaders. This board employs a Scout Executive, professional staff, office staff and two camp rangers to handle the administrative duties of the organization. The council is a participating agency of the United Ways of Manatee, South Sarasota, Charlotte, Lee, Hendry/Glades and Collier Counties.

THE DISTRICTS

The Southwest Florida Council operates through a structure of four districts. Alligator District serves all of Collier County. Manatee District serves all of Manatee County. Panther District serves all of Lee County and western Hendry County. Two Rivers District is comprised of Charlotte County, Sarasota County and the Arcadia area of DeSoto County.

The Service Center for the council is located in the George "Andy" Sanders Service Center, 1801 Boy Scout Drive in Fort Myers. This office, completed in 1995, contains office and a conference center, plus a fully stocked National Scout Shop. This shop carries all materials, uniforms, insignia and other related merchandise used in the Scouting program.

THE CAMPS

The Southwest Florida Council has two full service camps for use by Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venturers and Explorers. The Price-Sanders Scout Reservation (Camp Miles) is located on State Road 74 in Charlotte County. Camp Flying Eagle, located on the Little Manatee River in Manatee County, is one of the oldest Boy Scout camps in the state of Florida. Both of these camps offer a variety of campsites, have full dining halls, boating areas, shooting sports ranges, campfire arenas and swimming pools. Both camps have rangers who live on-site. Facility reservations for both camps must be made through the Scout Service Center.

LEADERSHIP TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

EVERY YOUTH DESERVES A TRAINED LEADER

ON-LINE TRAINING

All leaders who are new to the Cub Scout, Boy Scout or Venturing programs need the orientation provided through Fast Start Training. The Fast Start video series answers the questions, "Ok, I volunteered. Now what do I do?" for all leaders. Other trainings available for all leaders is: Youth Protection, Safe Swim Defense/Safety Afloat, Climb On Safely, Trek Safely, Hazardous Weather, Cub Scout Specifics and Troop Committee.

NEW LEADER TRAININGS

Newly designed training programs emphasize the progression from Cub Scouting all the way up to Venturing. All leaders start with the "This is Scouting" session that presents a solid overview of the BSA's values-based program. Next leaders attend the course designed for their specific Scouting position. Cub Scout leaders will attend Cub Scout Leader Specific Training with breakout sessions for Tiger, Cub Scout & Webelos Den Leaders, Cubmasters and Pack Committee Members. Boy Scout Leaders will attend the Boy Scout Specifics Training and Outdoor Leader Skills Instruction. Venturing Specific Training is designed for adult crew leaders.

YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING

The prevention of child abuse is of the utmost importance. To help ensure the safety of our members, every adult leader should take Youth Protection Training. The training is renewed every 2 years. Any activity requiring a tour permit requires at least one trained leader to have Youth Protection Training (YPT).

BALOO

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation is a prerequisite to schedule a Pack Family camping trip. Cub Leaders learn how family camping fits into the Cub Scout program, as well as the policies necessary for conducting a safe outdoor program.

OWLS

Outdoor Webelos Leader Skills is beneficial to the Webelos leader to prepare Webelos Scouts for the patrol method of camping. Learn the skills necessary to plan for fun and safety new activities.

OLSI

Outdoor Leader Skills Instruction is the training every Boy Scouts Leader who plans on attending weekend camping trips with Boy Scouts should take. Learn the patrol method of setting up your site, cooking and skills instruction while having fun in to great outdoors.

WOOD BADGE

This course focuses on strengthening every volunteer's ability to work with and lead groups of youth and adults. Open to all leaders, not just troop leadership.

NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSIP TRAINING

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) stresses two important areas — Scoutcraft skills and leadership skills. Any Scouts or Venturers currently serving, or destined to serve in a leadership position and who will be 13 years of age or older, are encouraged to participate in this outstanding training.
