**Purpose:** To Examine GOD's Laws - Enjoy nature, and a magnificent facility.

**Who:** All Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, and Venturers, **in grades K through 12** of Southwest Florida Council, parents and siblings. Stroller and wheelchair accessible.

**Preparation:** Wear appropriate shoes and clothes (Class A – dress uniform), carry sufficient water to stay hydrated, wear sun block and insect repellent. Practice Leave No Trace and the Buddy System. A LIGHT LUNCH will be provided.

**Program:** Participants will “**Check in**” at **8:30 a.m.** at the Desk and be assigned a starting point along the hiking trail. Several stops are designated to examine a law. Law discussions will last approximately 10 minutes and travel time between stops of 5 minutes. (So, a law program starts on each quarter hour.) After all stops have been visited, we will gather at the Chapel for a Prayer Service and the distribution of patches.

- After the program, participants may visit other areas of the facility, and enjoy a light lunch.
