

2022 FAMILY F.O.S., 2022 Camp Card & 2021 FALL ANNUAL POPCORN SALE

The primary financial support to operate our seven-county council comes from self-generated sources (over 93%) such as the *Annual Friends of Scouting* (FOS) *Community & Family Campaigns*, special events/activities, *annual popcorn sale*, *annual camp card sale*, and other council revenue sources. These funds provide critical program support services for our units, 2,175 adult volunteers, year-round operation of the Price- Sanders Scout Reservation—Camp Miles, Camp Flying Eagle, council service center and many other vital support services that enables Scouting to operate in our community. Yes, it costs parents to be in Scouting, *but above and beyond this expense*, it costs the SWFL Council around \$285 <u>per</u> Scout, which adds up to a lot when you think of the thousands of youth in Scouting across the Southwest Florida region. Supporting the Annual Family FOS, Popcorn & Camp Card Sale effort enables the mission of Scouting to be delivered through quality programs and camp facilities to all Scouting families. **Without this support, Scouting would cost significantly more for all participants.**

QUALIFICATIONS

Achieve the unit goal using the "Best Methods" plan by April 30, 2022. (Goal based on approval by District Family Chairman & District Executive; District Family FOS Committee will

- (Goal based on approval by District Family Chairman & District Executive; District Family FOS Committee will communicate with unit committee chairman; *District Executive will verify if "Best Methods" plan is used*)
- 2. Conduct a unit presentation using the "Best Methods" plan that insures as many parents and leaders as possible are in attendance. "Best Methods" presentation is verified on audit form by Chr./DE). This should ideally be at a Blue & Gold Banquet, Court of Honor or other gathering where all parents are in attending.
- 3. Schedule your 2022 presentation by December 31, 2021.
- 4. Complete your presentation and <u>achieve</u> your unit goal <u>by</u> April 30, 2022.(*Recognition period begins when* goal is achieved & runs from May 1- May 1 annually- Any unpaid FOS pledge from previous year will not count towards achievement of current year unit goal until paid)

QUALIFICATIONS

- A unit must participate in the 2021 Annual Popcorn Sale, 2022 Camp Card Sale and conduct a 2022
 Family Friends of Scouting program <u>using the "Best Methods" plan for each</u>. (District Executive & Chairmen
 verify if "Best Methods" plan is used) "Best methods for popcorn and camp card is having an <u>organized</u> kick-off
 effort and having 50% of your active youth selling.
- 2. Recognition: Unit is not charged an individual per Scout/parent/leader camp usage <u>camping</u> fee of \$5 (Non-Honor Unit) per person per day for individual unit week-end camping at Camp Flying Eagle or Camp Miles. Note: Most all other BSA councils charge units camp usage fees \$3-5 per person/per day <u>plus</u> equipment- program area usage fees (pool, canoes/kayaks etc.) even with selling popcorn-camp cards so this is <u>significant</u> recognition and savings for all SWFL Council units. (Recognition period begins when goal is achieved & runs from May 1- May 1- Popcorn 2021-Camp Card 2022-FOS 2022). (Units must also have no outstanding past due balances owed)

Additional Program/Insurance Recovery Fees charged in addition to the annual membership fee by other Florida Councils will range from **\$9 to \$60 in 2022.** The Southwest Florida will have a **\$1** annual accident/sickness insurance fee per participant(same since 2010). Future program fee implementation will be considered in subsequent years pending the <u>continued</u> strong support and <u>100%</u> of all units participating and growing the 2021-22 Scouting calendar year Popcorn, Annual Friends of Scouting, and Camp Card programs.
