**Purpose:** To Examine GOD's Laws - Enjoy nature, and a magnificent facility.

<u>Who:</u> All Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, Venture Scouts, Explorers, and Sea Scouts <u>in grades 1 through 12</u>, of the Southwest Florida Council, parents & siblings. Stroller and wheelchair accessible.

**<u>Preparation</u>**: Wear appropriate shoes and clothes (Class A –field uniform), carry sufficient water to stay hydrated, wear sun block and insect repellent. Practice Leave No Trace and the Buddy System. A LIGHT LUNCH will be provided. Follow current Covid 19 guidelines concerning community events.

**Program:** Participants will **"Check in"** beginning **at 8:00 a.m**. at the Desk and will be assigned a starting point along the hiking trail. Several stops are designated to examine a law. Law discussions will last approximately 10 minutes and travel time between stops of 5 minutes. (So, a law program starts on each quarter hour.) After all stops have been visited, we will gather at the Chapel area for a Prayer Service and the distribution of patches.

• After the program, participants may visit other areas of the facility, and enjoy a light lunch.
