BALOO & IOLS TRAINING

BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation)

This one-and-a-half-day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. BALOO training consists of an online pre-requisite component in addition to an overnight, hands-on practical. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the discovery of the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience. Completion of this course is mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult on a Pack overnighter. Bring your online completion certificate with you.

To complete the online training, log into My.Scouting.org, click on BSA learning Center and then BALOO. You can also take Hazardous Weather training online under the Program Safety module.

IOLS (Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills)

Working as patrols, this hands-on course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain their First Class rank. Along with Scoutmaster Specifics, Youth Protection Training, and Hazardous Weather Training, this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in a Boy Scout Troop to be considered "trained". If you are a new leader, this training is essential to help you make the most of your time and effort and have a lot of fun while you're at it so grab your tent and plan to join us!
