Cancellation Policy:	Once registration fees have been paid, an individual may become ill or otherwise unable to attend an event. An exception will be made if a request is received in writing or email (not phone) and submitted to the Southwest Florida Council Office by the individual no less than 72 hrs. before the date of the event.
