Adult Outdoor Skills Training

Cub Scouts - BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation)

Requirement: Mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult to be BALOO trained on a Pack overnighiter.

Pre-Requisite: Log into my.Scouting.org -> Menu -> My Training -> Expanded Learning -> BALOO

This one-and-a-half-day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. BALOO training consists of an online prerequisite component in addition to an overnight hands-on practical. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the discovery of the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience. Completion of this course is mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult on a Pack overnighiter. Bring your camping gear, chair, mug and something to take notes with. Login to my.scouting.org with your account to take the online prerequisite BEFORE arriving at camp.

Scouts BSA - IOLS (Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills)

This course will provide Scouts BSA leaders with the basic outdoor skills information needed to start and guide a program the right way. The skills taught are based on the outdoor skills found in The Scouts BSA Handbook. It is a requirement for Scoutmasters & Assistant Scoutmasters to be positioned trained.

Cost: \$30 Registration fee includes all course materials and meals. Online registration and payment.

\$15 Non-certificate pre-approved Trainer/Staff Registration includes meals. Online registration/payment.
