CLEARLY MARK ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR

Note: This equipment list is meant to serve as a guide.
Use your discretion in choosing what to bring and
what to leave. **Things do get broken or lost. Please
plan accordingly and leave valuable items at home.**

Clothing

- FULL SCOUT UNIFORM
- JACKET/SWEATER
- PONCHO/RAIN GEAR
- LONG PANTS OR SHORTS
(Enough for 5 days of Camp)
- SCOUT APPROPRIATE T-SHIRTS
(six or more)
- UNDERWEAR (six pair)
- CLOSED TOED SHOES
- SOCKS (six pairs)
- SWIMMING TRUNKS
- PAJAMAS
- HAT OR VISOR
- HANDKERCHIEF
- HIKING BOOTS & HEAVY SOCKS
- OA SASH

Closed toed shoes must be worn everywhere
except the pool decks and lake front

CAMP NECESSITIES

- TENT
- SLEEPING BAG
- FLASHLIGHT WITH FRESH BATTERIES
- TEN ESSENTIALS
- CANTEEN OR WATER BOTTLE

TOILET KIT

- TOOTHBRUSH/TOOTHPASTE
- SUNSCREEN
- COMB AND/OR BRUSH
- INSECT REPELLENT
- HAND SOAP
- KLEENEX
- BATH TOWEL
- BEACH TOWEL

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- SUNGLASSES
- CAMERA
- COMPASS
- AIR-MATTRESS
- DRY BAG OR TRASH BAGS

Merit Badge Items

- MERIT BADGE BOOKS

FOR PATROL AND/OR TROOP

- PATROL BOXES (optional)
- LANTERNS
- PATROL FLAGS & POLES
- TROOP FLAG (Troops will assemble
behind your troop flag each day on the
parade field)
- CAMPSITE DECORATIONS

MONEY IN CAMP

We recommend that one of the adult leaders serve as
the "banker" for each troop, holding the money for each
Scout, and issuing it to him in small amounts. Most
Scouts bring around \$80 to camp.

MEDICATIONS

All medications should be turned into the Troop
leadership for safekeeping during the week. Our
Medical Lodge can store medications that have to be
refrigerated. Please always keep items like Epi-Pens and
inhalers with you.
